SECTION 1: BACKGROUND & EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1.1. About Us

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SECTION 2: SEWP

On May 1st, 2015, NASA implemented their 5th generation of the most widely used and one of the easiest Government Wide Acquisition Contracts, SEWP V. Solutions for Enterprise Wide Procurement (pronounced "soup") is a multi-award Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) vehicle focused on IT products and product-based services.

NASA has awarded 120 contracts to Small, Disadvantaged Business, which offer a wide range of advanced technology including tablets, desktops and servers, IT peripherals, network equipment, storage systems, security tools, software products, cloud-based services, video conferencing systems, and other IT and audio-visual products. Product based services such as installation, training, maintenance and warranty are also available through SEWP. As an OMB authorized GWAC, the SEWP V contract is utilized by all Federal Agencies.

Cynergy Professional Systems was awarded a SDVOSB contract under SEWP V offering Motorola Products and Services as a Premier Partner. SEWP is a Government-Wide Acquisition Contract

- Agencies approved by OMB for IT Product/Service GWACs
 - GSA, NIH, & NASA
 - Other agencies may have targeted GWAC authority
- Based on Clinger-Cohen Act
- Pre-award activities/verifications already performed at basic contract level
 - \circ $\,$ e.g.: business size and financial responsibility determinations, etc.
- Open to All Federal Agencies and their Authorized Support Contractors
- All Federal Agencies have utilized SEWP

- Not a traditional searchable catalog
- Quote Request Tool available online
- Quotes are verified against contract catalog

Dynamic Catalog


- Items added to contract based on customer requests

SECTION 3: USING THE CONTRACT

The scope of products and services that can be provided is the same for all SEWP Contract Holders.

All business sizes are represented on SEWP. Set asides, such as, economically disadvantaged woman owned or HUBZone small businesses, can be issued at the RFQ level.

The SEWP website provides the only SEWP recommended tools for product and provider searches and for Request for Information/Request for Quotes (RFI/RFQ) — the Quote Request Tool (QRT).

Use of the SEWP Quote Request Tool method for obtaining quotes automatically incorporates price reasonableness, scope and availability determination, Fair Opportunity compliance, Program level tracking and support, and display and flagging of issues at the contract, manufacturer and line item level, among other factors.

IT Buyer/Contracting Officer

Make Your IT Product Service Decision

- Procurement Issues Delivery Order (DO) specifying NASA SEWP Contract Holder
- Use Email tracking to track orders from beginning to end keeping customers and Contract Holders in the loop and accountable



DO sent to SEWP

- SEWP PMO also: Resolves Issues (CHRM); Manages technology refreshments; Provides quality assurance; Monitors Contract Holder performance
- Within 1_Business Day SEWP: Verifies Order; Sends DO to Contract Holder

SEWP Contract Holder gets DO from SEWP and then:

- Processes Order
- Delivers Order



2.8. Delivery

The delivery time varies based on the size, complexity and type of the order. Quotes should include a delivery timeline. If one is not provided on the quote, a 30-day delivery time is assumed.

2.9. Warranty

OEM provided warranty, extended warranty, customized warranty, and maintenance plans, which include software updates and security patches are available upon request.

2.10. Post Delivery Issues

2.11. Product Returns

In accordance with FAR Part 52.212-4, The Government may require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or re-performance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government must exercise its post-acceptance rights — (1) within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered or should have been discovered; and (2) Before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect of the item.
